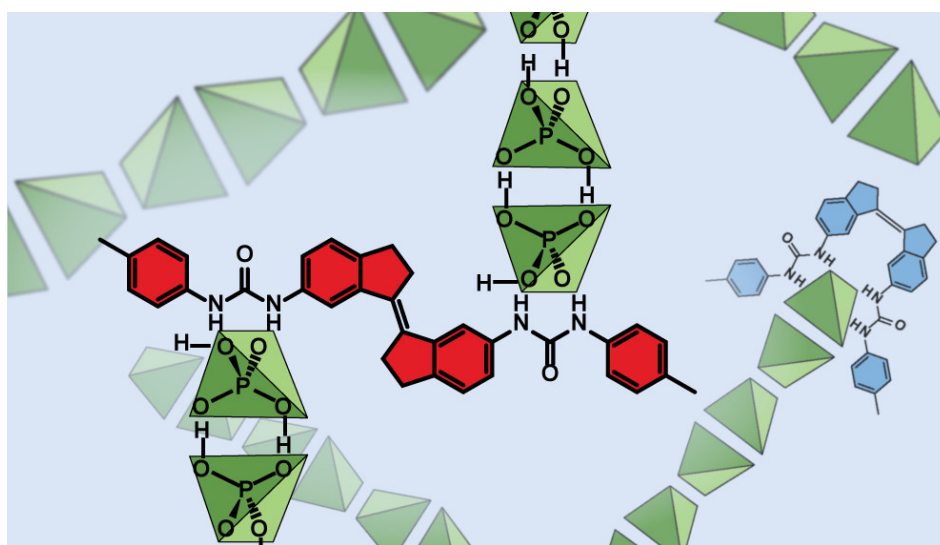


Controlled diffusion of photoswitchable receptors by binding antielectrostatic phosphate oligomers

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We used time-resolved diffusion NMR spectroscopy techniques we recently developed¹ to study the behavior of photoswitchable anion receptors² in solution. Our surprising results on the formation of antielectrostatic oligomers will be presented.³
